BOOKS AND COURSE MATERIALS

The ICPSR Summer Program encourages its instructors to provide all required and supplementary course readings for free on their course Canvas websites. In some instances, an instructor may assign a textbook or coursepack that requires purchase by the participant. Please check the syllabus for the course(s) you are taking to determine if there are any required course books or materials that must be purchased.

COMPUTERS, SOFTWARE, INTERNET, AND PRINTERS

Summer Program participants are expected to provide their own laptop computer.

Many of the statistical applications available at the Summer Program can be installed to your computer for free. There are some commercial applications that are available only in the Summer Program virtual desktop environment.

In-person participants have access to the free, secure wireless internet provided by the University of Michigan on campus. In-person participants can print on campus using the MPrint service, which charges \$0.06 per black and white letter-sized impression, and \$0.23 per color letter-sized impression.

HOUSING

Housing costs are not included in the registration fee. On-campus housing is available for both sessions; rooms will be located in a student dorm on the University of Michigan's central campus and within walking distance of all General Session courses.

The nightly rate for a single room is \$57. Linens (mandatory) cost \$16 for the first week of a block, and \$6 for subsequent weeks.

Leases are available for the following blocks of dates:

- Sunday, June 9 Saturday, June 15, 2024 (First Session week 1): \$358
- Sunday, June 16 Saturday, July 6, 2024 (First Session weeks 2-4): \$1,168
- Sunday, July 7 Saturday, July 13, 2024 (Second Session week 1): \$358
- Sunday, July 14 Saturday, August 3, 2024 (Second Session weeks 2-4): \$1,168

You can purchase housing for a single block, or for all four blocks of dates. If you purchase adjacent blocks, your stay will be continuous over the connecting Saturday (you will not need to check out or back in, and can remain in the same dorm room). The Summer Program will cover the nightly cost for the connecting Saturday, at no charge to you.



Participants may also make their own arrangements to sublet a room or apartment in Ann Arbor. The cost of housing in Ann Arbor can vary widely, depending on whether you have roommates and what kinds of amenities the rental offers. Please refer to our <u>General Session housing page</u> for a full list of options.

MEALS PLANS AND GROCERIES

Dining hall meal plans are available for purchase for participants in on-campus housing (the dorm rooms do not have their own kitchens). Participants can choose to pre-purchase a specific number of meals in advance when they register for on-campus housing, or they can choose to pay via credit card at the door (more expensive than pre-purchasing meals in advance).

Please note that University of Michigan dining halls do not accept cash.

Groceries tend to cost between \$75-\$150/week. If you like to dine out, plan to spend between \$7-\$15/meal.

TRANSPORTATION

The <u>University of Michigan bus system</u> is free to the general public, with reduced hours during the spring/summer terms and on holidays. U-M bus routes serve the central and north campuses.

<u>The Ride</u> operates buses across Ann Arbor and Ypsilanti. All of TheRide's buses are accessible to persons with disabilities. Each is equipped with a ramp and accommodates 2 wheelchair users; there is also a bike rack in front that can carry 2 bikes. Fare is \$1.50/ride or \$3.00/day-pass.

DISCOUNTS

We offer the following discounts on our registration fees:

- **On-Campus Housing Discount:** In-person participants who select the University of Michigan on-campus housing option will receive a 10% discount on their registration fee.
- **Discount for Returning ICPSR Summer Program Participants:** If you took an ICPSR Summer Program course in a previous year, you receive a 15% discount on your registration fee in this year's ICPSR Summer Program.
- Multiple Enrollment Discount: Participants who register in two or more topical workshops, or a topical workshop and a General Session, are eligible to receive a 15% discount off their total registration fees.
- **Group Discount for Academic Departments or Programs:** We offer a group discount for academic departments or programs that send four or more participants within the same year. Please visit our <u>registration page</u> for the full discount policy.
